2012 Art in the Open
Projecting Free Time



As part of the 2012 Art in the Open Festival, the Island Media Arts Cooperative is seeking submissions of short experimental videos that will be projected for 3 evenings onto the Confederation Centre Theatre building in Charlottetown. Submitted videos should be under 15 minutes in length and will be selected in terms of the artist's consideration of audio/visual innovation, and their relationship to the theme of 'projecting free time'. Video, as a time based media, has an intrinsic relationship to space, movement, attention, captivation and audience. Free time as a theme can approach ideas concerning: leisure, the social, imagination (fantasy/ escape) , creative process, meditations, relevancy of time, astronomy, etc. This list can easily be expanded upon.

Artist's can submit as many videos as desired for the project, but will receive one artist fee despite the amount of videos submitted. Videos will be reviewed and selected by a curator in relationship to the theme 'projecting free time'. Both audio and visual components will be available for the project.

requirements for submission:

DVD with selected video(s) in .mov file. note: do not burn the DVD, raw .mov files only.
a short (1 paragraph) description of the video(s).
artist's CV
